Objectives

- To establish a landscape structure and character capable of fully integrating into the site periphery and its wider setting.
- The creation of wildlife habitats which both increase and diversify landuses suitable for ecological enhancement and which meet Essex County Council Mineral Site restoration for Biodiversity Supplementary Planning Guidance (June 2016).
- The promotion of local amenity and wellbeing benefits through the provision of Proposed Public Rights of Way, linking in with existing routes.
- To restore agricultural land back to high quality Best and Most Versatile Land Characteristics.
